Shooting Investigation

Lake City Police Department Officers responded to a call of shots being fired in the area of Dade and Avalon Streets. Citizens in the area reported seeing a black Dodge Charger occupied by three white males drive past 297 Avalon Street and fire a gun out of the window. A B.O.L.O was put out for the vehicle and a short time later the vehicle was stopped by Columbia County Sheriff's Deputies near the intersection of U.S. 41 and Guerdon Street. Officers from the Lake City Police Department made contact with the suspects and Deputies. Lake City Police Officer Brian Bruenger interviewed the suspects on scene. He recovered two firearms and developed probable cause to arrest two subjects. There were no injuries in this incident. The initial investigations describes the shooting a result of a verbal argument. It is anticipated additional charges will be filed leading to another arrest.
